The company may be within the security industry or a security department within the wider business community. The nominee must be able to demonstrate an example or examples of product innovation, process innovation or service innovation that has delivered benefit to the business or the customer. They should also include a brief explanation of how innovation has been encouraged in the organisation or relevant department/division.

A shortlist of finalists will then be selected and invited to meet with the judging panel where they will be interviewed and judged against 5 common criteria recognised as fostering innovation; 1) Strategy & Leadership; 2) Culture & Climate; 3) Planning & Selection 4) Structure & Performance 5) Communication & Collaboration.

The award for 'Innovation in Security' will be presented at the ISIA Awards 2014 on 1st November 2014 at Powerscourt Hotel. The event is formal and dress code is black tie.

The Judging Panel
